Self-testing of Covid-19 in Dalarna

If you are experiencing symptoms, please do make an appointment for testing. You can only submit one test for each sickness period. Remember that only people with symptoms should take the test.

The test is free of charge.

The method of conducting the test differs depending on age.

Adults and youths from the age of 13 and above

You should make an appointment for covid-19 self-testing (PCR test) in Dalarna, if any of the following apply to you:

- You have symptoms of Covid-19
- You have had symptoms for at least 24 hours
- You are a so-called household contact (hushållskontakt) and have been informed that you will be tested
- You have been instructed by an infection tracing officer (smittspårare) to take a test

You can take the test sample yourself from the nose and throat with a sampling stick.

A parent or guardian must assist youths under the age of 16 to take the test.

You login to the 1177 health care e-services with Mobile Bank-ID, Bank-ID, Freja E-ID Plus or other form of E-identification. You can then choose the test location and time.

Children from the age of 10 to 12

Parent or guardian are recommended to make an appointment for self-testing if:

- The child is showing symptoms of Covid-19
- The child has had symptoms for at least 24 hours
- The child is a so-called household contact (hushållskontakt) and has been informed that testing must be done
- The child has been instructed by an infection tracing officer (smittspårare) to take a test

The parent or guardian must assist the child to take the test. A parent or guardian logs in to 1177 health care e-services and orders a test via proxy (ombudsläge) and assists the child with the test.

Children from preschool class up to and including year 9

A parent or guardian is recommended to book an appointment for testing of the child, which is conducted by staff at the health care centre.

A parent or guardian calls the health care centre and makes an appointment for testing.
